- \* Onsite Exploratory (Concurrent) Session presenters and ONE co-presenter receive free onsite conference registration including lunch the day of their presentation(s).\*
- \* Virtual Exploratory (concurrent) Session and Interactive Workshop presenters and ONE co-presenter receive free virtual conference registration (virtual conference registration includes all virtual events ONLY Monday through Thursday).\*

### Responsibilities

- \* Virtual presenters must have access to the conference provided Zoom account
